ESF project closing conference



At 15 December 2011, the Estonian ESF project had its closure conference in the Europe Clarion Hotel in Tallinn. The ESF project aimed to pilot the EQUASS Assurance system to seven rehabilitation service providers in Estonia. Moreover, the project intended to raise awareness on quality of rehabilitation services to a wider sample of sectorial stakeholders, and to build capacity for a further roll-out of EQUASS throughout Estonia in case of a positive evaluation.

As result of the project, 6 pilots have been awarded with the EQUASS Assurance certificate and the implementation process have been appreciated and valued by all pilot sites.

Various Estonian stakeholders and representatives of the seven pilot sites that implemented the EQUASS Assurance requirements in their organisation attended the conference. Contributions to the conference were given by Keiu Talve (project manager), Mare Nabor (AS welfare Services, pilot site), Matti Lilleväli,(Equass auditor), Siim Mõistus (client Hapsula Neurological Rehabilitation Centre), Sirlis Sõmer-Kull, (Ministry of Social Affairs), Guus van Beek (EQUASS Key Expert), Michael Crowley (EQUASS consultant), Jan Spooren (EPR Secretary General) and Hanno Pevkur (Minister of Social Affairs). All speakers address the issue of delivering quality in the provision of rehabilitation services from various perspectives. The ESF project was also recognised as a 'best practice' for its effective and efficient way of management and implementation of the EQUASS requirements in the seven pilot sites. As result of this successful project all 100 Estonian organisation providing rehabilitation and social welfare service will be encouraged to implement the EQUASS Assurance requirements in the coming year.

Astangu Vocational Rehabilitation Centre will act as Local Licence Holder in Estonia and will be responsible for coordination of the implementation till 2015. Representatives of the project management, pilot sites and the 'EQUASS Crew' from Brussels have closed the project in an informal challenging event. They all survived the challenges of climbing high in tree and facing all kinds of obstacle between earth and sky.

The partners in the project are providers of VET services for persons with disabilities in Europe:

Rea College Nederland Pluryn (NL) including RCN-Bartimeus (NL) and RCN-Heliomare (NL), Opera Don Calabria (IT), BBW Adolf Aich gGmbH (DE), CENTERKONTURA (SI), the Rehab Group (IE) and Vilnius Centre for Psychosocial Rehabilitation (LT).

The project will begin with cross-referencing the EQUASS and EQAVET principles and frameworks, identify discrepancies, and provide the necessary adaptations.

This project will then provide the partnering institutions with the opportunity to implementation EQAVET framework through the following steps:

- method of self-evaluation and detailed planning,
- sharing experiences and identification and exchange of good practice (bench learning),
- implementation of a system for internal auditing and peer review,
- recognition of successful implementation of EQAVET framework (certified VET-provider)
